Dear White Plains High School Families,

I am delighted to join you as Principal of White Plains High School and to welcome you to a new school year. Also new to the high school this year are Assistant Principal, Ernie Spatafore and North House Administrator, Syntyche Alston. We have many new staff members that join the high school this year, including - Christiana Bentivoglio-DiVaio and Huan Li, Foreign Language; Kimberly Fleming, Giordano Garcia, Timothy Henkels, John Hughes, Science; Michael Lambert and Jack Sibrizzi, Math; Porfirio Lopez, Social Studies; Lillian Diaz-Withers, Guidance, Cheryl Rosenka, English, Katherine Neglia, Library Media Specialist; Annette Adamiak, Student Activities; and Cathy Barnes, Bookroom.

The mission of the WPCSD is clear: to educate our students in a manner that is defined by our commitment to nurture, and inspire and to prepare our students to be good citizens who contribute in a diverse and dynamic world. We have our work cut out for us!

Our students must know the language of math and music, and be able to write as well as they speak and to speak as well as they think. And they

need to be flexible, agile thinkers- able to connect content with context and interpret context quickly and confidently. We live in a time when our students must be independent, secure thinkers as they navigate the wild, often uncharted landscape that is the virtual world.

They must be equipped to sort through misinformation and propaganda with confidence and ease- they must think critically, analytically and quickly. They will need to practice using their voices effectively to advance theory and to transform theory into practice.

These, we imagine, are fundamental, essential skills in this century. Our students will work with and among people whose lives are dissimilar to theirs and many of them will likely work at jobs that don't exist today. We must teach content but also the skills that will enable our students to collaborate effectively, to assess information and content accurately so that they are able to, as our mission states, fully contribute in a diverse and dynamic world.

We know that learning is an emotional process that depends on interpersonal connections and mutual respect –and that students learn

from teachers with whom they are connected and comfortable in classes where they are engaged and are encouraged to be partners in their own learning.

We also know that without the support, and involvement of our students' parents and guardians, grandmothers and grandfathers, aunts, uncles, brothers and sisters, our students and our teachers will have a tougher road to travel.

I encourage you to use the Parent Portal in Infinite Campus to monitor your child's attendance, academic progress and to view report cards and health records. We also encourage you to reach out to us when you have concerns, ideas or questions.

It is my pleasure to join the White Plains High School Community and to work on behalf of our students.

I look forward to meeting you at our Open House on Thursday, October 4.

Parent/Guardian Portal in Infinite Campus

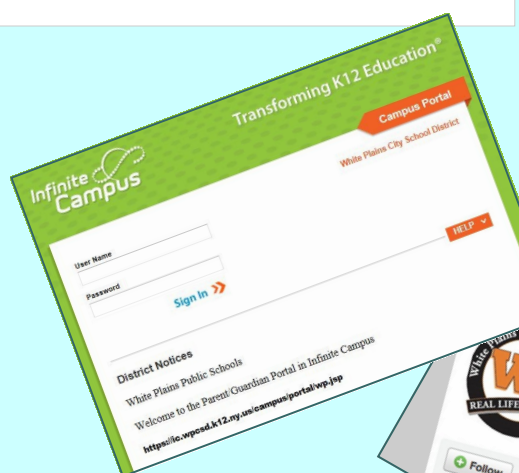

GUIDANCE NIGHT

Director Of Guidance, Lesley Tompkins

Lesley Tompkins, Director of Guidance, will provide parents with an overview of the Guidance Department's role and resources available to students and parents!

To high-light, resources such as access to student grade books via the **Infinite Campus Parent Portal**, as well as **NAVANCE**, an online college and career planner used by counselors and students, and other college related accounts (COLLEGE BOARD, ACT,

COMMON APP) will be discussed (for juniors and seniors).

Breakout groups with a guidance counselor (GC) for each grade level will then meet with parents to review events during a typical calendar year as well as address any questions you may have in regards to your child.

Some questions you may have:

- When will the sophomore GC begin to transition in for my rising freshman?
- How does the GC help with schedule

and course choices?

- What does the PSAT mean to my 9th/10th/11th grader? How do parents see the results?
- When should my child begin to go on college visits? Where can I get more information on colleges?
- Should my child take the SAT or ACT or both?
- What does early action, early decision or regular decision mean in the college application process?

All of these and more will be discussed by the guidance counselors.....bring your questions!

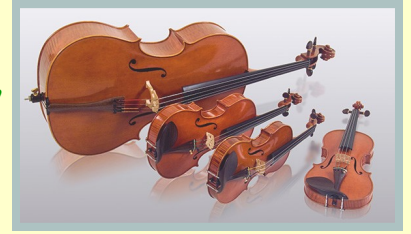

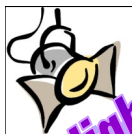

- not be in prison or on parole for a felony conviction



- not be adjudged mentally incompetent by a court;
- not claim the right to vote elsewhere

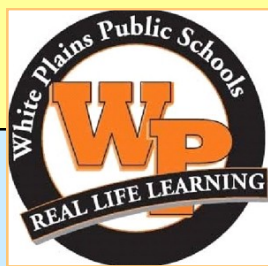

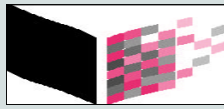

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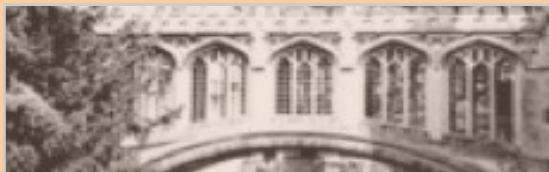
